

# PROJECT ROLL UP COVID-SAFE STUDENT INDUSTRY PLACEMENTS



**Project Roll Up** is an industry placement experience with a difference! Victorian secondary students (aged 15 years and older) can gain valuable industry experience in a COVID-safe environment, develop connections with potential future employers and influence the thinking of decision-makers.

Over seven weeks, students from across Victoria will work online in project teams, engage with health, community, industry and youth sector experts, and use design thinking to develop inspiring ideas and recommendations to support students and young people as part of Victoria's Roadmap in response to COVID-19.

Student teams will present their ideas to a panel of experts and decision-makers. Each student will receive a certificate recognising their participation.

This placement is perfect for any student interested in or currently studying health and community services, business or media and can be accredited as Structured Workplace Learning or Work Experience.

## FORMAT



**IDEATION** - Students form project teams and explore the design challenge.



**FORMULATION** - Teams develop, test and refine their ideas, and prepare their pitches.



**PRESENTATION** - Teams pitch their ideas and recommendations to a panel of experts and decision-makers.

# KEY OUTCOMES



## INFLUENCE HOW YOUNG PEOPLE ARE SUPPORTED

Victorian students and young people have played a leading role in recent months, rolling up their sleeves to get vaccinated in massive numbers.

This design challenge will focus on how students and young people can be supported to stay safe, healthy and connected to education, training and employment opportunities, as part of Victoria's Roadmap in response to COVID 19.

What are the most important things students and young people will need in the coming months and years to live happy, healthy and fulfilling lives?



## INDUSTRY PLACEMENT THAT BUILDS JOB-READY SKILLS

Students will develop and demonstrate highly sought after job-ready skills, such as problem-solving, communication, innovation and teamwork.

Students will also receive credit for Structured Workplace Learning or Work Experience.



## CONNECT WITH MENTORS AND EXPERTS

Students will engage with mentors and experts from health, community, industry and youth sectors and build connections with potential future employers.
